

## Education



This education program was developed to inform the public of the services that we offer and the importance of recycling in Woodlynne. Our intention is to show the public how recycling can affect them economically and environmentally. By following the guidelines and rules in this program, we can increase participation – which will save tax dollars and reduce the need for enforcement.

## Enforcement and Auditing

**First and foremost, RECYCLING IS THE LAW. Recycling has been mandated in New Jersey since 1987 – that's 29 years!!!**



*For the Enforcement and Auditing portion of this program, we will be using stickers and door hangers to notify residents of any violations.*

We will be going out on trash day to do audits or inspections of the trash. At first, we will be looking for the obvious: cardboard boxes or open containers with significant amounts of recyclable materials. We will be placing stickers on these items and they will not be picked up, that week. When the recyclable materials have been properly separated and recycled, the trash will be picked up, the following week. Records will be kept of all sticker and door hanger violations and repeat offenders will be issued fines. These stickers and door hangers will be clearly marked with the violation and have the recycling hotline number on them, if there are any questions.

The mixing of trash and recyclable materials will not be tolerated. If trash is found mixed in with recycling, it will not be picked up, either. Recycling containers will only be used for the recycling of single stream materials or the recycling of yard waste. If trash is put out in a recycling container, it will not be picked up. Door hangers will be used for enforcement in the other recycling services that we offer. There are rules and guidelines for each service that we offer and they are listed in each outline.
